Another useful model for contributor agreements is the one that we provide to our own authors and anthology editors—adapt the agreements to your own use by replacing UC Press with the name of your publishing program. Refer also to language your contract under clause 4(c) of your contract.

Library of Congress Cataloging-in-Publication Information

UC Press recommends that you register the Publications with the Library of Congress www.loc.gov as major on-line retailers are now taking advance information from LOC and listing it in their databases. You may obtain a Library of Congress Control Number (LCCN) by requesting forms directly from the Library of Congress office. It is also advisable to reprint "Cataloging-in-Publication" data on the copyright page of your book, although the LCCN is sufficient for most libraries. If you do not register your book for copyright but request CIP from the Library of Congress, you must send 2 copies of the published book to the LOC to avoid penalties.

ISBNs and Bar Codes

UC Press requires a 13-digit ISBN for all titles in the program. The Bar Code is the ISBN number as an industry-standard machine readable Bookland EAN coding. The application may ask you if your books are distributed by another publisher. List University of California Press as your distributor (ISBN prefix 0-520). For publishing partners delivering finished books, UC Press requires that all books have an ISBN and bar code on the back cover of the book and that cartons be labeled as described in our Packing and Shipping Instructions.
